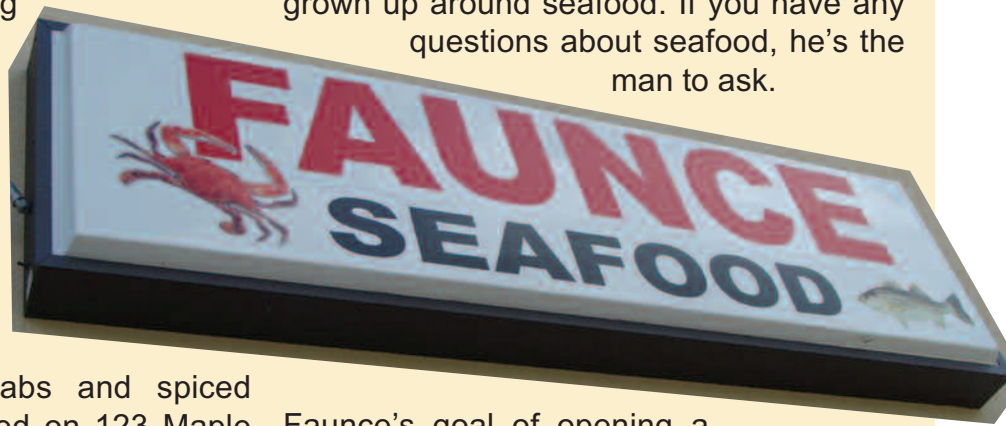

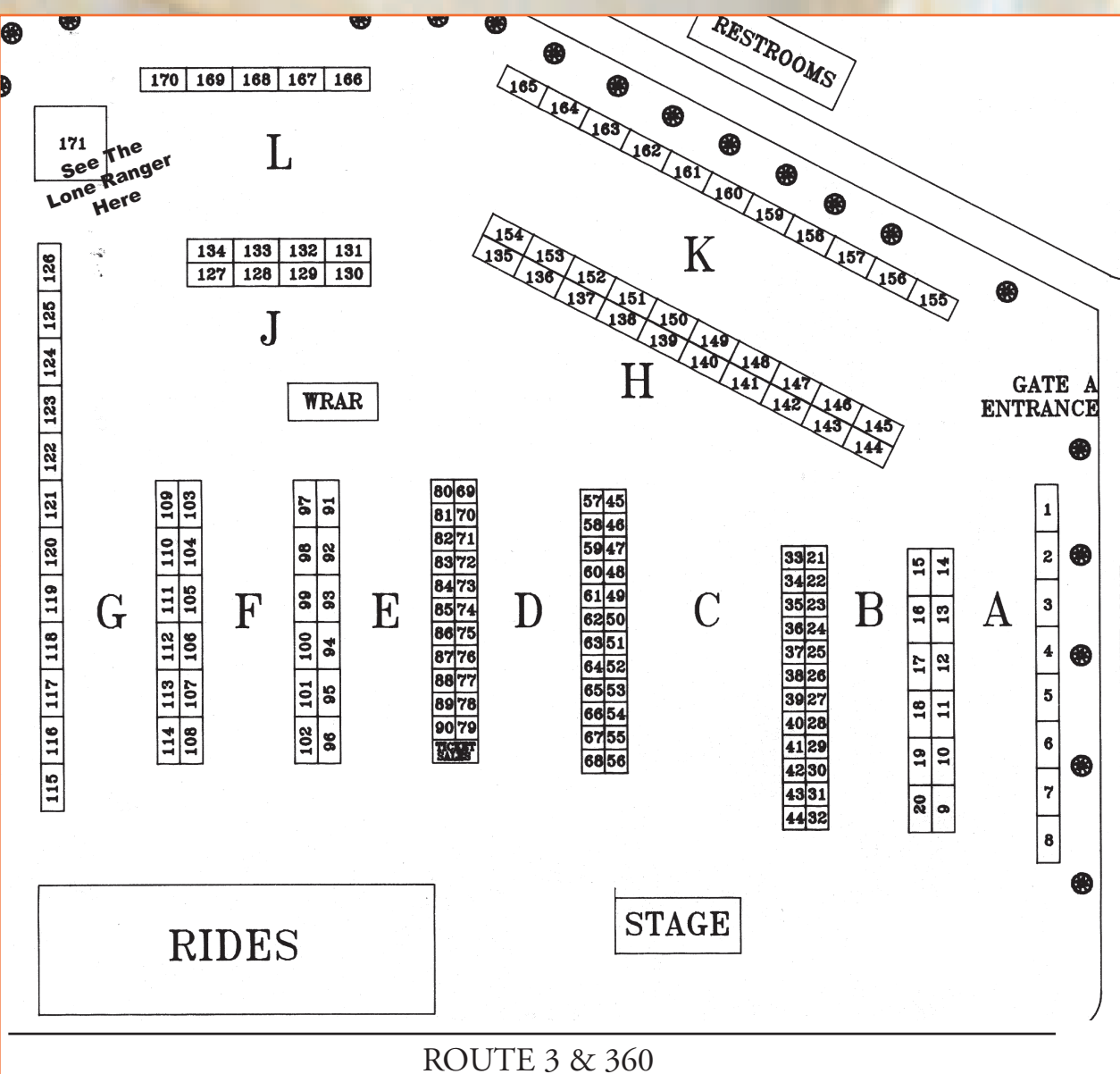

# Richmond County YMCA

A place of our own. That was the theme of the Richmond County YMCA capital campaign. However, that is now the theme of local teenagers. The YMCA provides a teen center full of games and activities so that they have a place of their own, thanks to a contribution from the Bank of Lancaster. "I can remember being a teenager here in the Northern Neck, and you always heard everyone saying, there is nothing for teens to do, I still here teenagers saying the same thing," said Philip Belfield, YMCA Branch Executive.

"I know the YMCA Teen Center will not cure all boredom for all teens in our county, however I believe it is a step to provide a safe, positive place for many," continued Belfield. Playstation, Xbox, internet access, air hockey and a pool table are just some of the amenities in the center.

There is also a conference table for teens to use for meetings, homework, playing cards or for use during the tutoring that goes on during the school year. The YMCA has long had teens and teen programming a part of the branch agenda.

Over the past 12 years in Richmond County, there have been teen councils, teen parties, over night outings, trips to theme parks, volunteer opportunities and even teen employment programs. More teen programs are on the way according to the YMCA staff. Dani Jones, a Warsaw resident, works part

time for the YMCA and will begin providing teen services very soon. She is currently gathering applications from interested local teens that would like to serve on the teen council. The council will help review the needs of the teen community and plan the events.

The YMCA offers a discounted rate for high school students to stay active through exercise and have full use of the YMCA Teen Center. "We can provide programs and events for teens every weekend, but I believe teenagers really just want a place of their own, where they can just hang out," concluded Belfield.
